Focus manually. Set the camera to a Creative Zone mode (P, Tv, Av, M, B, or C exposure mode.) In these modes, you can tell the camera to base focus on a specific autofocus point. Again, these steps assume that you aren't shooting in Live View mode or recording a movie. Set the Mode dial to P, Tv, Av, M, B, or C.

To focus manually: After setting the lens switch to the manual focusing position, rotate the focusing ring on the lens. (On many lenses, including the kit lens, you can damage the lens if you rotate the focusing ring with the switch in the AF position.)

Basics of Viewfinder Focusing on the Canon Rebel T5/1200D ...

When you switch to manual focus, the camera won't focus the lens. Manual focus is performed by rotating the focus ring on the lens barrel -- not via any buttons on the camera. The buttons on the camera simply let you select which AF point or points you want to use when the camera performs focus (if the lens is in auto-focus mode) or for focus-confirmation (if the lens is in manual focus mode).

Try switching the camera to "P" mode. Manually select the center AF point. The camera should always use that point for focusing. Use "One Shot" focusing until you become comfortable using the center AF point, then switch to AI Servo for tracking moving subjects.

Aiming with a single point: Single-point AF (Manual Selection) Establishes focus on a single point. This mode allows you to establish focus with a single manually-selected AF point. All AF points other than the selected one are disabled. The Single-point AF mode excels in focusing accuracy.
