There are several types of medications used to treat osteoporosis. 1. Anti-resorptive drugs: These medications prevent bone resorption (breakdown) and can help increase bone mass. Examples include alendronate (Fosamax), risedronate (Actonel), raloxifene (Evista), ibandronate (Boniva), calcitonin (Calcimar), and zoledronate (Reclast). 2.
