### **Telecommunicator Training Program Manual - Michigan**

Any Telecommunicator hired by a primary PSAP on or after December 13, 2011, is required to complete the minimum training standards described in this manual. Funding for this training is available through Public Act(P.A.) 32 of 1986 to qualified PSAPs that submit an application and follow funding guidelines.

Telecommunicators and Emergency Medical Dispatchers must complete training and field training within 18 months of hire. Complete the appropriate Field Training Manual (listed in the forms section below). Obtain First Aid and CPR Certification. Sign Telecommunications Code of Ethics (usually occurs during basic training).

Entities wishing to become a Department approved training program shall submit Form DH 5067, 911 Public Safety Telecommunicator Training Program Application, all supporting attachments, and the application fee at least 60 days BEFORE the beginning of a class. Training program approvals are valid for two years from the date of issuance.
