Students wishing to transfer credit to Texas Tech from a nonaccredited institution must (1) complete 30 semester credit hours of work in residence at Texas Tech with at least a 2.0 GPA and (2) receive approval from the academic dean in order to validate credits for transfer.

TTU Registrar: Transfer Credit - Texas Tech University

Students may transfer up to 66 credits from a two-year and an additional 24 credits from a four-year institution that may be applied to a degree. Students must complete the last 30 credit hours of required coursework through Texas Tech University.
